

The Journey Adventure Program

A two day a week program for 6th grade students that teaches responsibility and respect for self, others and surroundings. Your children will have a fun and rewarding time in active game playing while learning and laughing!

This program was put together to enhance what your children already know deep within themselves. They will leave feeling empowered and full of pride!

During each session they will have great fun attaining skills such as: Creative problem-solving, decision making, relaxation techniques for stress reduction (which helps with focusing and creating peace within oneself), building cooperation, teamwork and trust.

Classes will be held at Windermere School.

The Journey Adventure Program ends at 4:30. Students will be dismissed at that time and parents are asked to meet them near the front office.
